**45 Little Pinnochio 95m A2+**

Branches out L from *Bisso of Orange*. Written up as "an interesting excursion", the route is an aid climb on natural gear with some bolts. Locate line of bolts to start. FA: Matt Perchard and J. Clarke, 1998.

**46 Bisso Of Orange 175m 26 \***

Fully bolted route starting on the LHS of the central main face. Good slab climbing plus a hard pitch on the headwall. The holds are a little friable on this route.

1. 25m (16). Chossy first pitch. Dangerous run-out to first bolt. 6B.
2. 30m (22). 10B.
3. 30m (22). 10B.
4. 35m (22). 12B
5. 25m (26). 10B.
6. 30m (21). 12B.

**47 Into The Mystic 150m 25 \*\*\***

A tribute climb to Bob McMahon, the pioneer of Bare Rock. Every pitch is a winner. Shares the same start as *Sapphire Rose*. Starts halfway up the big R-rising ramp in the centre of the cliff. There is a DBB after each pitch. Descent: Take double ropes to rap the route.

1. 30m (22). 10B. Up the line of U-bolts through the small roof, then go L at the FH to the small ledge with the tree. Thin slab move up to the anchors.
2. 25m (25). 9B. Superb sustained climbing on small holds.
3. 20m (24). 8B. Traverse L for several metres, then up to a thought provoking crux on the slab, followed by a pumpy move through the small roof.

4. 40m (22). 14B. Best pitch for the grade on Bare Rock. Sustained steep slab.

5. 35m (24). 10B. Mindblowing steep pitch on superb orange rock, with great exposure.

**47a Mystic Sapphire 20m 22 \*\***

Terrific link pitch between the second belay of *Sapphire Rose* and the third belay of *Into The Mystic*. Climb the first two pitches of *Sapphire Rose* (22, 21), then traverse L via the link pitch (5B) to join *Into the Mystic*, and continue up its fourth pitch (22). Creates a sustained four pitch route at grade 21/22, and bypasses the two crux pitches of *Into the Mystic*. FA: Gerry Narkowicz and Andrew Martin, June 2013.

**48 Sapphire Rose 95m 22 \*\*\***

Popular sports route. Take 17 draws and two ropes for the descent.
